Administration of Medication

Title 18A, Chapter 115, Laws of 1973 requires written consent by the parent and the physician before a prescribed medication may be administered to a student in school.

Nurse Practice Act, N.J.S.A. 45:11-37 states that only licensed individuals shall administer medication to students.
