State required assessments allow learners, families and educators to check-up on how well students are meeting the goals outlined by the NJ Student Learning Standards <https://www.nj.gov/education/standards/>

HS GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

All 11th grade students must take the NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment to demonstrate comprehensive understanding in English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science.

TYPES OF ASSESSMENT

There are several types of assessment of student learning:

- **ACCESS** for English Language Learners
- **DLM** for specific populations of students receiving support services
- **NJGPA** for eleventh grade students to determine graduation requirement fulfillment
- **NJSLA** for grades 3 through 9 in English Language Arts, mathematics and science. Other grades may be required to take the assessments if not completed in a previously enrolled year/cycle.
